S.T.A.B.L.E. is designed for all healthcare personnel who provide care for well or sick newborns. S.T.A.B.L.E. is the mnemonic for Sugar, Temperature, Airway, Blood pressure, Lab work, and Emotional support. This is an educational program for ALL providers to organize care from pre-transport through the post-resuscitation stabilization period. Participants will receive STABLE cards and current STABLE Program cardholders will have their STABLE cards renewed.

Per STABLE requirements, learners are required to have a copy of the **6<sup>th</sup> edition** STABLE learner manual, and pre-assessment questions completed prior to arriving. *More details on registration page.*
