### Obstetric Emergencies: Identification and Nursing Management

Eclampsia, shoulder dystocia, uterine rupture and other obstetric emergencies can be catastrophic and occur without warning. This class is designed to utilize the four R's: Risk assessment, Recognition, Response, and Reporting as a method to optimize outcomes for pregnant women. Protocols and guidelines for each clinical situation will be reviewed in a case presentation format.

#### Objectives:

At the conclusion of this program, participants will be able to:

- Review and understand the physiologic changes of pregnancy that affect maternal compensation & decomposition
- Discuss and highlight abnormal conditions that contribute to the severity of obstetric emergencies
- Describe the immediate nursing interventions for women with: shoulder dystocia, uterine rupture, hemorrhage, eclampsia, and umbilical cord prolapse

### Identifying Mews: Maternal Early Warning Signs Aimed To Prevent Morbidity and Mortality

Maternal death and severe morbidity are relatively rare obstetric outcomes. Because clinical conditions associated with these adverse outcomes are rare they often go unnoticed. This class will emphasize recognition and validation of maternal early warning signs and introduce standardized protocols aimed to save lives and reduce maternal morbidity.

#### Objectives:

At the conclusion of this program, participants will be able to:

- Identify specific vital signs and blood loss parameters that are warning signs of impending maternal decline
- Explore experiences from perinatal nurses when caring for women who have unexpected decompensation
- Emphasize the importance of clinical assessment and communication to heighten staff awareness and surveillance
